Sub : Role of 5 man Committee in sowing & harvesting dispute.

It has come to the notice of the Govt. that some confusion has arisen in certain quarters in the matter of solving sowing and harvesting disputes and affording police protection to the cultivators vis-à-vis the role of the 5-Man Committee. It is reiterated that recommendation of 5-Man Committee is only advisory in nature. For a dispute which can not be settled locally, the BLLRO should invariably cause an enquiry and take into account the recommendation of the 5-Man Committee but must invariably form his own opinion and then submit on that basis, a self-contained report to the concerned SDO for action in accordance with law.

If the concerned cultivator has sought Police protection, the BLLRO's report should accompany a petition from the cultivator seeking police protection so as to enable the SDO to initiate action appropriate for the case.
