NOTIFICATION

Section 26 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and in terms of sub-rule (1) of Rule 27 of West Bengal Minor Minerals Rules, 2002 as amended, the Governor is pleased to authorize the Executive Engineer of the respective vision attached to Irrigation & Waterways Department to grant quarry permit in accordance with W.B.M.M. Rules, 2002 to act or remove river bed materials from any specified land on pre-payment of royalty at the rate/rates as may be fixed from some to time.
