However, instead of a notification, the Central Government brought in the Right to fair Compensation and Transparancy in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement ( amendment ) Ordinance No. 4 of 2015 which was replaced by second amendment ordinance no 5 of 2015 wherein the provisions of LARR Act 2013 in respect of determination of compensation were made applicable to Acquisition under the NH Act, 1956. When the ordinances lapsed, the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparancy in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement removal of difficulties Order No. SO 2368 (E) dated 28/08/2015 was passed. The Order came into effect from 01/09/2015. Accordingly the guideline No. 3398-LA, dtd. 07/12/2015 was issued. From the above it is clear that the CALAs were empowered to declare the award with 100% solatium during the period between 01/01/2015 till 30/08/2015 on the basis of Ordinance no 4 & 5 of 2015.
