Sir ,

1. This is to inform you that Sri. _____, s/o _____ of Village: _____, P.O. _____, District Burdwan unauthorisedly extracted and stored and removed/transported ordinary sand / ordinary clay / Morrums / Brick Earth / Marbel for commercial use which is minor mineral in terms of Section 3(e) of Mines & Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act. 1957 (67 of 1957) as ammended read with Notification issued by Ministry of Stell & Mines, Deptt. Of Mines , Govt. of India , which minor minerals belong to and are in possession of the Govt. from the lands mentioned in the schedule below without any permission from the appropriate authority nor without holding an quarry permit/ Mining Lease as required under the provisions of the West Bengal Minor Minerals Concession Rules 2016 and has thus committed theft of ordinary sand / ordinary clay / Morrums / Brick Earth / Marbel by way of trespassing into the land & sub soil and causing public nuisance.
2. That the classification / character of land cannot be changed without the permission of the Collector. Hence, the conversion of land effected due to unauthorised extraction of minor minerals from the plots scheduled below makes the accused liable to be prosecuted **u/s 4D of the WBLR Act. 1955.**

2. Such unauthorised extraction and removal and also storage of minor minerals makes the person mentioned above liable to be prosecuted under section 4D of the WBLR Act. 1955 , Rule 50 of the West Bengal Minor Minerals Concession Rules, 2016, Section 21(1) & 21(4) of Mines & Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act. 1957 (67 of 1957) as ammended read with Section 378/379/410 I.P.C. and Rule 3 of W.B. Minerals (PREVENTION OF ILLEGAL Mining, Transportation & Storage) Rules , 2002.
3. I ,being empowered U/S 26 of the Mines & Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act. 1957 (67 of 1957) as amended, would therefore request you to kindly arrange for prosecution of the offender stated above SCHEDULE OF LAND (whereform minor – mineral extracted unauthorisedly) under the law in force and take necessary steps for seizure of stolen Govt. properties mentioned above including machineries and other alamats, as mentioned under section 21(4) of the Mines & Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act. 1957 . You are further requested to stop operation of the Brick Field / Tile Field / Sand Quarry wherein from such minor minerals are used / extracted / stored / removed/ transported .
4. **This may be treated as an F.I.R.**
