MEMORANDUM

In partial modification of this Department Memo No.131-IRC dated 17th July 2015, it has been decided by the Government to allow movement of 10 wheeler vehicles to carry sand and other riverbed materials during the dry working season, i.e. 15th October to 15th June subject to the ceiling limit of volume of materials fixed in accordance with the safe axel load as well as gross vehicular weight as stipulated below.

- a) Maximum quantity as per road permit (Challan) should not exceed 330 cft of sand.
- Maximum permissible gross volume during measurement on roads / check posts should not exceed 400 cft of sand to account for the effect of bulkage.
- 2. Movement of 10 wheelers shall be restricted during the monsoon season, i.e. 16th June to 14th.
 October in order to prevent damage to roads, bridges and embankments.
