ORDER

In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (I) of
section 24 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act,
1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government hereby authorises the officers
mentioned in column 2 of the Schedule below to exercise the power
specified in clause (b) to (f) of sub-section (I) of that section in
relation to any mine within the State of West Bengal for the purpose of:

- i) Collection of royalty and rent;
- ii) Prevention of illegal extraction of minerals;
- iii) enforcement of orders of the State Government to
suspend or close mining operations;
- iv) stopping and checking illegal movement of minerals; and
- v) in the case where renewal of a prospecting licence is
applied for, ascertaining the necessity thereof.
