The following draft amendment, which the Governor, in exercise of the power conferred by section 60 of the West Bengal Land Reforms Act, 1955 (West Ben. Act X of 1956) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), proposes to make in the West Bengal Land Reforms Rules, 1965, issued with the Department's Notification No. 15918-L, dated 15th September, 1966, published in *Calcutta Gazette, Extraordinary, Part I*, dated 12th October, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), is hereby published for the information of persons likely to be affected thereby.

The draft will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of fifteen days from the date of its publication in the *Official Gazette* and any objection or suggestion with respect thereto, which may be received by the undersigned before the said date, shall be duly considered:—

Draft amendment

In sub-rule (1A) of rule 21 of the said rules,—

- (1) *omit* the words “and giving an electronically generated notice in the website to all concerned for raising any objection, if any, within thirty days of general notice”;
- (2) *omit* the words “within the specified period”;
- (3) in the first proviso,—
 - (a) in the first line *omit* the word “proposed”;
 - (b) *omit* the words “without giving any notice in the website to all concerned for raising any objection under this sub-rule”;

(4) after the first proviso *insert* the following proviso:

“Provided also that where the name of recorded *raiyat* and the seller is different the correction in record-of-rights shall be done by the Revenue Officer concerned after physical hearing.”
