No. 7204-L.Ref.—25th April 1964.—In exercise of the power conferred by section 59 of the West Bengal Estates Acquisition Act, 1953 (West Bengal Act I of 1954), the Governor is pleased hereby to make after previous publication as required by sub-section (1) of the said section, the following amendment in the West Bengal Estates Acquisition Rules, 1954, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), namely:—

Amendment

To sub-rule (1) of rule 4A of the said rules, add the following further proviso, namely:—

“Provided further that in any area of the transferred territories, the choice for retention of land under sub-section (1) of section 6 shall be exercised by an intermediary within the 31st day of July 1964, by furnishing the statement referred to in this sub-rule in relation to all his estates or interests.”.
