Land has been acquired for various projects from time to time under various statutes. Upon completion of the acquisition process, ROR should be corrected in favour of the Requiring Body.

However, it is seen that RORs continue to feature the name of the erstwhile raiyats in many cases leading to several litigations & complications.

Hence, there is a need to ensure that mutation is done and records are updated in respect of all past LA cases where the process of acquisition has been completed.

I am to request you to take initiative to prepare a list of such cases to hand it over to all the concerned requiring bodies for making application for mutation. If mutation fees have already been deposited by the requiring body, the same may be transferred to the appropriate head of account. If not, separate fees may not be charged from State Government Departments for these old cases. Upon receipt of mutation applications, BLLROs shall accord priority and complete the process. The entire exercise may be completed within December, 2016.
