## ORDER

The issues relating to compensation for tea bushes and tea shade trees in connection with acquisition of tea garden land for various public purposes like construction of National Highways, State Highways etc. have been under active consideration of the State Government for some time past. After taking into consideration the recommendations of the Tea Board of India and in consultation with the Finance Department, the PWD & the Forest Department, the Governor is pleased to fix the rates for tea bushes and shade trees as follows:-

i) For tea bushes

: Rs. 135/- per bush in plain areas

Rs. 155/- per bush in hill areas

ii) For shade trees : Rs. 4,000/- per tree.

- The above mentioned enhanced rates of tea bushes and shade trees will come into effect from 1st January, 2015 and will be applicable to those land acquisition awards declared on or after 01.01.2015.
- This order issues in cancellation of the earlier order vide No. 2028-LA/3M-13/2002 dated 04.07.2006 of this department.
