<u>Sub</u>: Brief guideline for Tenant code and Possessor Code updation in R-o-R and flagging of non-transferrable land.

Ref: 1) This Office Earlier Memo No. 62/139(22)/Comp/2017 dated 04/04/2018.

2) This Office Earlier Memo No. 62/137(22)/Comp/2017 dated 25/04/2018.

It has been observed that in various khatian the respective tenant type is not properly codified against the R-o-R viz. Tenant Code [01] i.e. রামত has been assigned against a khatian of সেবাইত or পাটা or Tribal Land where Sec. 14C of the WBLR Act, 1955 applies or any other tenant type. But for that khatian the respective tenant code of সেবাইত or পাটা or Tribal Land ought to have been used. This erroneous tagging of tenant code is opening up the scope of any unauthorized transaction through the system and also subsequent generation of Mutation Cases on such transactions in future.

Considering the gravity of the matter he is requested to instruct all the BL&LROs under his jurisdiction to follow the below mentioned process to update the tenant type properly and in a exhaustive manner against each khatian with special emphasis on **Tribal Land where Sec. 14C** of the WBLR Act, 1955 applies:

- 1. After logging into the system the authorized user can view the tenant code already flagged against in each khatian through রিপোর্ট-→মৌজা ভিত্তিক-→ দথলকারের সংক্ষিপ্ত বিবরণ where all the khatians of that mouza will be displayed.
- 2. If it is found that there is any erroneous tagging of Tenant Code aganst any Khatian necessary updation of Tenant code is to be done through রেকর্ড সংশোধন → ক্রটিপূর্ণ তথ্যের সংশোধন, on selection of mouza and khatian necessary tenant code to be updated by selecting দ্যলকারের ধরণ পরিবর্তন and then go through all its subsequent steps required for any correction through the module of ক্রটিপূর্ণ তথ্যের সংশোধন up to tamilling of that particular case.
- 3. In the same manner all the erroneous tenant types are to be updated for all the mouzas.
- 4. The tenant types which are required to be updated are listed hereunder:
- [0] ভারত সরকার, [2] সেবাইত, [3] মাতোয়ালি, [5] পাট্টামূলে দং, [8] লেসী, [A] রাজ্য সরকারের দপ্তর, [B] রাজ্য সরকারের অধীনস্থ সংস্থা, [C] পুর সংস্থা / পঞ্চায়েত, [E] ভারত সরকারের দপ্তর, [F] ভারত সরকারের অধীনস্থ সংস্থা, [G] সরকারী/আধা সরকারী শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠান, [I] ঠিকা প্রজা, [J] আদিবাসী (14C ধারা মতে)

A list of Scheduled Tribes relating to West Bengal is annexed herewith for perusal and guidance. Further, during the course of flagging, it may also be kept in mind that whenever a member of the Tribal Community purchased land from a Non-Tribal person(s) and gets his/her name recorded in the R-o-Rs, That land also becomes a Tribal Land and thus flagging be done forth-with.

Similarly, it has also been observed that for a good number of occasions, R-o-Rs have been opened through the system with wrong possessor code or no possessor code with mere noting about the possessor type in the 'Remarks' column, resulting in opening up the scope of any unauthorized transaction through the system and also subsequent generation of Mutation Cases on such transactions in future. Hence, these entries are also required to be updated through the system to assign appropriate possessor code against the plots within the R-o-R. A detailed SOP for execution of such rectifications in eBhuchitra has already been circulated to all the districts on 25/04/2018 which is enclosed herewith again for ready reference. Therefore, he/she is requested to instruct all the BL&LROs under his/her jurisdiction to update the possessor type properly and in a exhaustive manner against each R-o-R as per the enclosed SOP.

A periodical compliance report may be forwarded to this end for perusal and further guidance.

B. Constitution Orders

The Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 19501

C.O. 19

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 341 of the Constitution of India, the President, after consultation with the Governors and Rajpramukhs of the States concerned, is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

- 1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950.
- 2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the castes, races or tribes or parts of, or groups within, castes or tribes specified in²[Parts to³[XXIV]] of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the States to which those Parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Castes so far as regards member thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them in those Parts of that Schedules.
- ⁴[3. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 2, no person who professes a religion different from the Hindu⁵ [the Sikh or the Buddhist] religion shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.]
- ⁶[4. Any reference in this Order to a State or to a district or other territorial division thereof shall be construed as a reference to the State, district or other territorial division as constituted on the 1st day of May, 1976.]



1:0: <u>Introduction</u>: Government of West Bengal is contemplating for introduction of a new system of automated mutation in the near future. Accordingly the process of modifying both eBhuchitra and e-Nathikaran application software is under progress. Before the actual roll out of the proposed system, exiting land records data is required to be updated in all respect to facilitate the flawless performance of the proposed system. One major requirement in this regard is updation of possessor status against plots i.e. plots which have been opened through the system with wrong possessor code, without any possessor code and with mere noting about the possessor type in the 'Remarks' column, are required to be updated through the system to assign appropriate possessor code against that plot in respective RoR.

1:1: <u>Purpose</u>: This SOP (Standard Operating Procedure) will describe the step-by-step process flow to be followed by the end user of eBhuchitra at block/service location level to update the possessor code of respective RoRs against the remarks noted in the remarks column. The entire interface is available in the eBhuchitra application in a separate sub-menu.

1:2: Possessor Types to be Flagged:

As per decision, the following Possessor Types have been required to be flagged from the said menu:-

- (i) [08] পাট্টামূলে বন্দোবস্ত
- (ii) [OC] বান্তজমি অধিগ্ৰহন
- (iii) [0D] ভূ: সঃ আইনের 4B ধারা প্রযোজ্য
- (iv) [0E] ঠিকা প্ৰজা
- (v) [0F] আদিবাসী (14C ধারা মতে)
- (vi) [03] বগা


2:0: General Procedure for Flagging of Possessor Details in eBhuchitra:

The general process flow to be followed by the end user of eBhuchitra for Flagging of Possessor Codes against respective Khatians, is described in short below:


1) First, user have to Log into eBhuchitra with url <u>http://10.16.200.55/eBhuchitra/</u> (for Reliance MPLS link) or <u>http://10.3.0.40/eBhuchitra</u> (for WBSWAN link).



- 2) Then the user have to select রিশোর্ট-→মৌজা ভিত্তিক-→ মন্তব্য সম্থালিত দাগের তথ্য and have to select Mouza name from the drop down menu and next, have to click the দরবর্তী button. This will generate the report of Khatian wise Plots of the selected Mouza against which any text is available in the 'Remarks' column. This report can be referred for identifying those plots which have been recorded in respective Khatian with mere noting of Possessor Status in the 'Remarks' column only, but appropriate Possessor Code may/ may not has been assigned against that entry. The print out of that report may be taken out to facilitate the Mouza wise completion of Possessor Flagging work in an exhaustive manner.
- 3) A specimen R-O-R is taken here as example for updation of possessor details (refer to the next image) where the there is a barga noting against the plot of that Khatian which is actually entered in the মন্তব্য instead of using the respective code for barga entry and বৰ্গা দং has been recorded in the 'Remarks' column of the said Khatian.




4) To update that possessor details, user have to proceed to ব্লেকর্ড সংশোধন স্থাতিয়ান সংশোধন স্থানদার ধরণ পরিবর্তন




5) In the দ্থলদার ধরণ পরিবর্তন page, user have to provide the মৌজা and থতিয়ান নং and there will be the dropdown option of plot list where the plots which contains non-codified remarks of that khatian will only be populated. The user will select the plot and details of the 'Remarks' column will be populated automatically in the respective fields (refer to the next image). The existing text in the 'Remarks' column will be non-editable. In the right hand side of the page, there will be a drop


down menu for 'Possessor Details' from which, user have to select the appropriate Possessor Type (For this particular case, it will be [03]- বৰ্গা)




6) On selection of বৰ্গা, the text box will open for entering the names and other details of the bargadar (see below image). Then click সংযোজন for submission of details.



7) On clicking the তামিল button, a confirmation text in red colour showing 'Possessor Updated Successfully....' will be displayed at the bottom of the page and the respective khatian will be updated with the new Possessor Status:



8) The updated Khatian will reflect the new possessor status as per the figure below. The existing 'Remarks' column of the source Khatian will remain unchanged.



9) The similar procedure is to be followed for updating all other related Khatians with appropriate Possessor Types i.e. codes [08], [0C], [0D], [0E], [0F] & [03] respectively as mentioned in Point 1:2 above.
